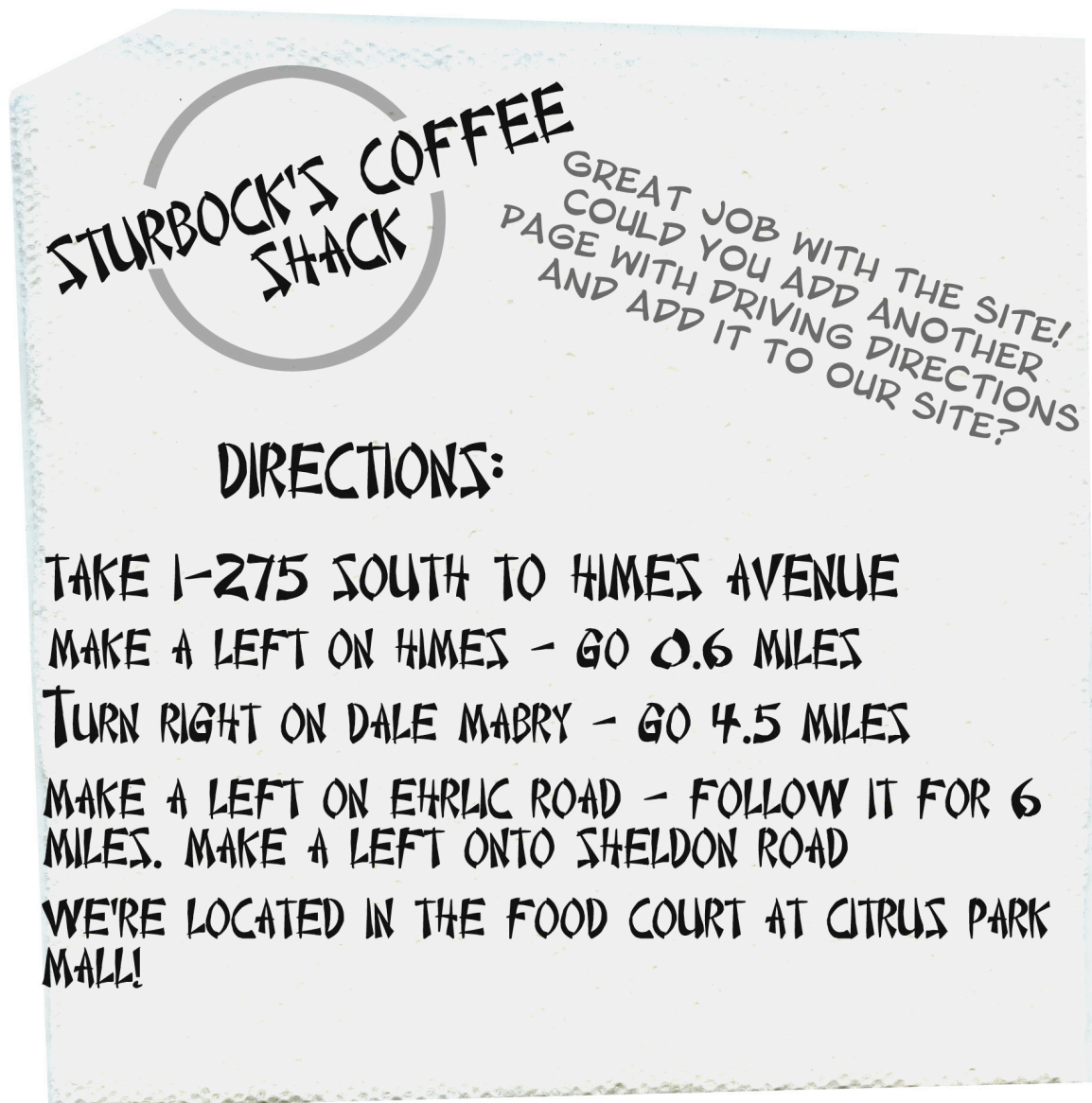

Links Assignment:

Objective: Gain familiarity with HTML syntax for adding relative links, links to images, and links to external sites.

Sturbock's Coffee Shack was very impressed with your initial website layout and would like you to build onto the site design you've created previously.



1. Create the directions above as a separate HTML file, and save it out as **directions.html**. Place this file in the same location as **sturbocks.html**
2. Open **sturbocks.html** and add a link to the **directions.html** file. Call the link DRIVING DIRECTIONS.
3. Open **directions.html** and add a link back to **sturbocks.html**. Call the link HOME.
4. Create a folder called **images** and make sure it is on the same level as the two HTML files you have been working with. You may have already done this from the previous assignment. Create a subfolder inside **images** called **drinks**
5. Find three royalty free images that are coffee drink related (<http://www.gettysimages.com>) and copy them into your **images/drinks** folder.
6. Add one image above each listed drink to your **sturbocks.html** file. You do not need to center these images.
7. Find a royalty-free image of a compass. Copy this file into your **images** folder. Add the image directly above the driving directions in the **directions.html** file. Make sure to center this image.
8. In the directions.html page, underneath the driving directions, create a sub-heading called MAPS
9. Add the following External Links under MAPS:
<http://www.mapquest.com> (Map Quest)
<http://maps.google.com> (Google Maps)
10. Check to make sure these sites can be accessed from your page.
11. In my drop-off box, in the **Class_3_Due** folder, make a new folder called **Firstname_Lastname**. Copy the entire contents of your HTML files and images into this location. Check to insure that your links and images work.
