

Creating an Image Gallery

Create an attractive thumbnail gallery for your restaurant's menu page.

Project Parameters:

- 1) Pick 5 images for breakfast items, 5 images for lunch items and 5 images for dinner items.
- 2) Make thumbnails for each image (no larger than 200px by 200px). Keep the thumbnails consistent in size.
- 3) Crop the large images so that they are all the same size (no larger than 600px by 600px). Keep the large images consistent in size.
- 4) Organize the thumbnail images into a folder called **thumbs** in your **images** folder. Create subfolders for **breakfast**, **lunch**, and **dinner**. Place the thumbnails into the appropriate folder.
- 5) Organize the large images into a folder called **large** in your **images** folder. Create subfolders for **breakfast**, **lunch**, and **dinner**. Place the large images into the appropriate folder.
- 6) Use tables to organize the thumbnail images in your menu page. Use table headings to describe the menu item for each image.
- 7) Use CSS to make your table attractive.
- 8) Put all your CSS elements in a separate file called external.css
- 9) Upload your work to your website. Test your page to make sure it works.
